



## Replacement Engine Harness for Painless 20101 Wire Harness

- 1. Disconnect the battery.
- 2. Remove the old engine harness from the engine.

  Note: Keep track of which color wire goes to each item to aid in installing new harness.
- 3. Unscrew the old engine harness firewall connector from the main harness and unplug.
- 4. Using a pair of needle nose pliers remove the old engine harness wires and terminals from the old engine harness firewall connector by squeezing the terminal and pulling the wire out. **See Illustration 1**.




**Illustration 1** Squeeze Terminal Then Remove

5. Use Illustration 2 or 3 (depending on which style firewall connector you have) to locate where to insert each new wire terminal into your old engine harness firewall connector.

**Note:** The connectors in illustration 2 and 3 are shown from the side that the wire would come out of.



**Illustration 2** Engine Harness Firewall Connector Style #1




Illustration 3 Engine Harness Firewall Connector Style #2

- 6. Plug the engine harness into the main harness after all the wires have been installed into the engine harness connector.
- 7. Route the other ends of the wires out and connect to the items as listed in illustration 2 and illustration 3.
- 8. Reconnect the battery and test for proper operation.
