















Depress the ClickLock™ release and remove one corner from cab rail.




Feed tarp dowel into cab rail. (NOTE: For easiest feeding action, place tarp on a flat smooth surface, and keep dowel straight while feeding into cab rail. Caution, pavement may scuff tarp.)





Reinsert corner piece into cab rail until it "clicks" and locks into place.








Longer Clamps Some trucks use different sizes of clamps to fit curved sidewalls. Longer clamps go in the forwardmost (Cab) positions while the shorter clamps hold the rails at the rear (tailgate) end.

FOR INSTALLATION IN THE **FOLLOWING TRUCK MODELS:**

Tarp may be rolled up and secured with Velcro® for bulk hauling



For each clamp mark on your bedliner a $1-1/2" \times 3"$ hole as shown above. Remove clamp. Cut holes in bedliner. Reinsert side rail clamp. Return to step 6.
