67/68 LEFT HAND REMOTE MIRROR INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Left door window needs to be rolled up completely before beginning installation.

2. Tie a very long string tightly around lower part of the mirror control handle. This string should be long enough to come out of the door with cables while leaving plenty inside the car.

3. After string is attached, move control handle to one side. Place needle-nose pliers in slots and turn counter-clockwise. Force apart the jaws into the grooves, loosen and remove transmission housing nut.

4. Remove the two screws that are holding the mirror on the door.

5. Pull assembly out of the door with long string attached.

6. When assembly is out of the door untie the string from the control handle and tie it to a long pencil or stick to keep the string from falling back into the door. Do the same at the other end of the string also.

7. Tie the string outside of the car to the handle of the new mirror cable assembly and drop the assembled cables down into the door.

8. Secure the mirror to the door with new gasket and screws, then pull cables into the car. Attach transmission nut and remove string. While sitting in the car, attempt to adjust the mirror.

9. If the mirror will not adjust, the outer head may need to be turned slightly up, down or sideways (it may be necessary to loosen the phillips screw in the back of the head). After adjustments tighten the phillips screw in the back of the mirror.
